

Hitting the Road

- You are not in a race. Take your time and let other vehicles pass.
- Give yourself 3 car lengths in front of you.
- Wide turns! Watch the camper in your mirrors in parking lots and tight roads like campground roads.
- The camper is close to 15 feet high. Be aware of low bridges and overpasses.
- Pick parking lots with plenty of room. Don't pull into a busy gas station. *
- Keep two hands on the wheel and relax, don't drive nervous.
- Use your signals
- Do a safety check at all stops and before leaving.

All doors and windows shut (including the awning and handle next to the door - latch it shut)!

Lights working

Highway Travel:

- Do not exceed 65-70 MPH The tires are not rated for higher speed. But do travel within the min speed limit.
- Get up to speed when merging.
- Stay to the right and pass only when necessary.
- Use signals on all lane changes.
- Use mirrors and be sure the lane is clear prior to changing lanes.
- Don't panic with wind or draft from a Mac truck.
- Have fun on your Vacation.

*When possible gas up prior to hooking up your truck or SUV. If you must pull into a gas station with a camper, pick an outside gas pump.
